"We've noticed in the past that with larger charities, it's sometimes hard to see where the contribution goes. Because of AAO's size, we can actually see the impact of our donation, and know what needs to be done next. It has a family feel. We can recognize the faces of the children, and learn the staff by name. That's a nice feeling.

"As a band, there are simple ways for us to spread the word about AAO and the work they do. We have passed out information at shows, and tried to be ready to answer questions (or at least get answers for people, if we don't know). Little things like wearing an AAO t-shirt on stage draws people's interest. It's all about word of mouth. We'd like to plan some fundraisers down the road, and get other bands involved. Maybe even a compilation CD, with the proceeds going to AAO. The possibilities are endless. But the first thing we did was sponsor the children."

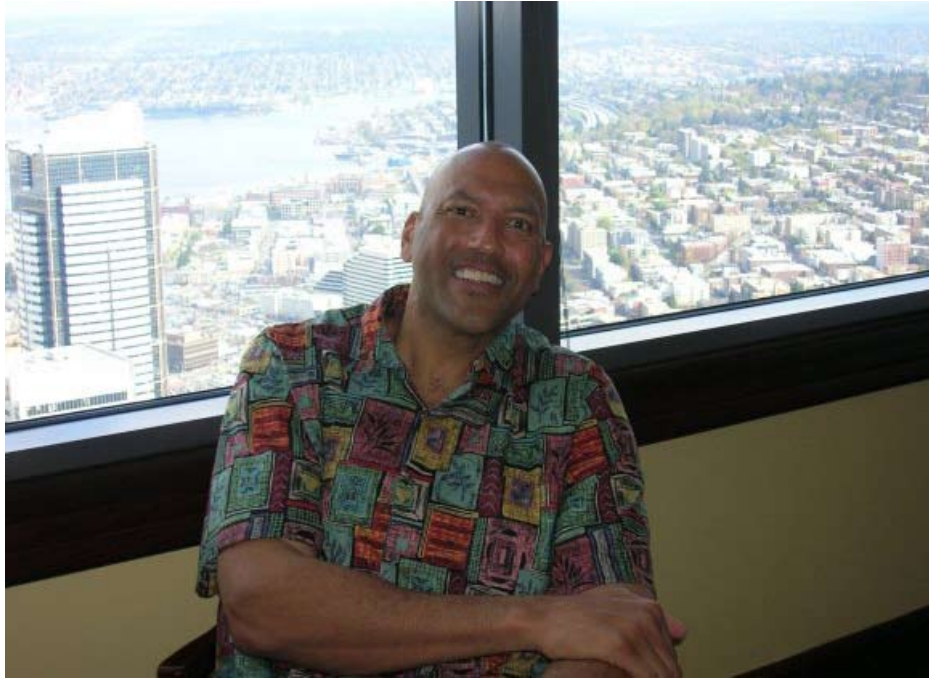
