

Notes for Principals and Teachers

- Encourage the students to write letters and send pictures to the children they are helping.
- Ask students to write reports on Sierra Leone, past and present.
- Incorporate the history of slavery as it relates to Sierra Leone, past and present, into the school curriculum.
- Introduce students to West African art, food and music.
- Encourage students to write fictional stories incorporating Sierra Leone and the children of All As One.
- Stage a "Culture Day" with West African food, music and dancing.
- Involve the students in brainstorming fundraising ideas for helping the children at the All As One Children's Centre. They always have the BEST ideas!
